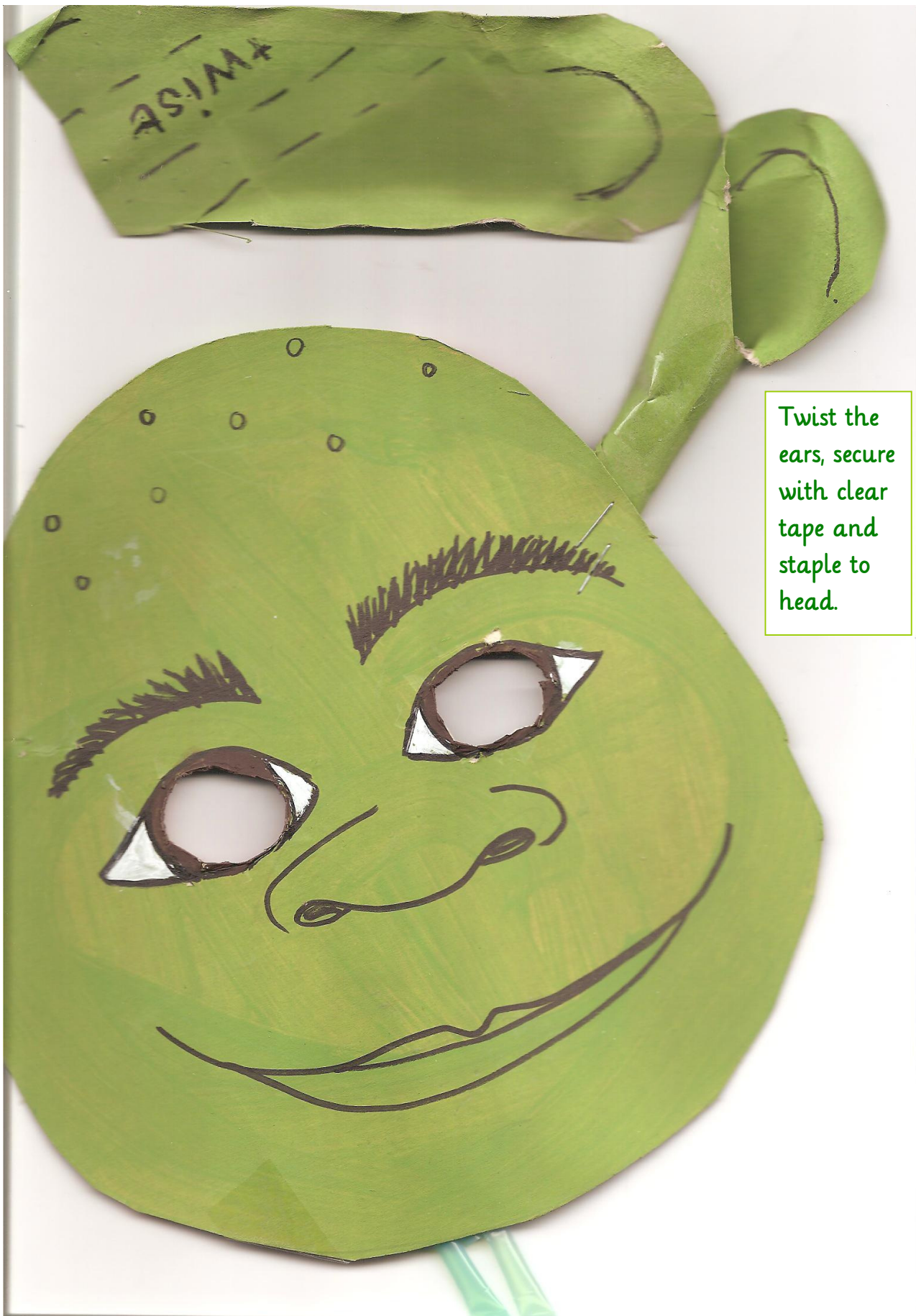
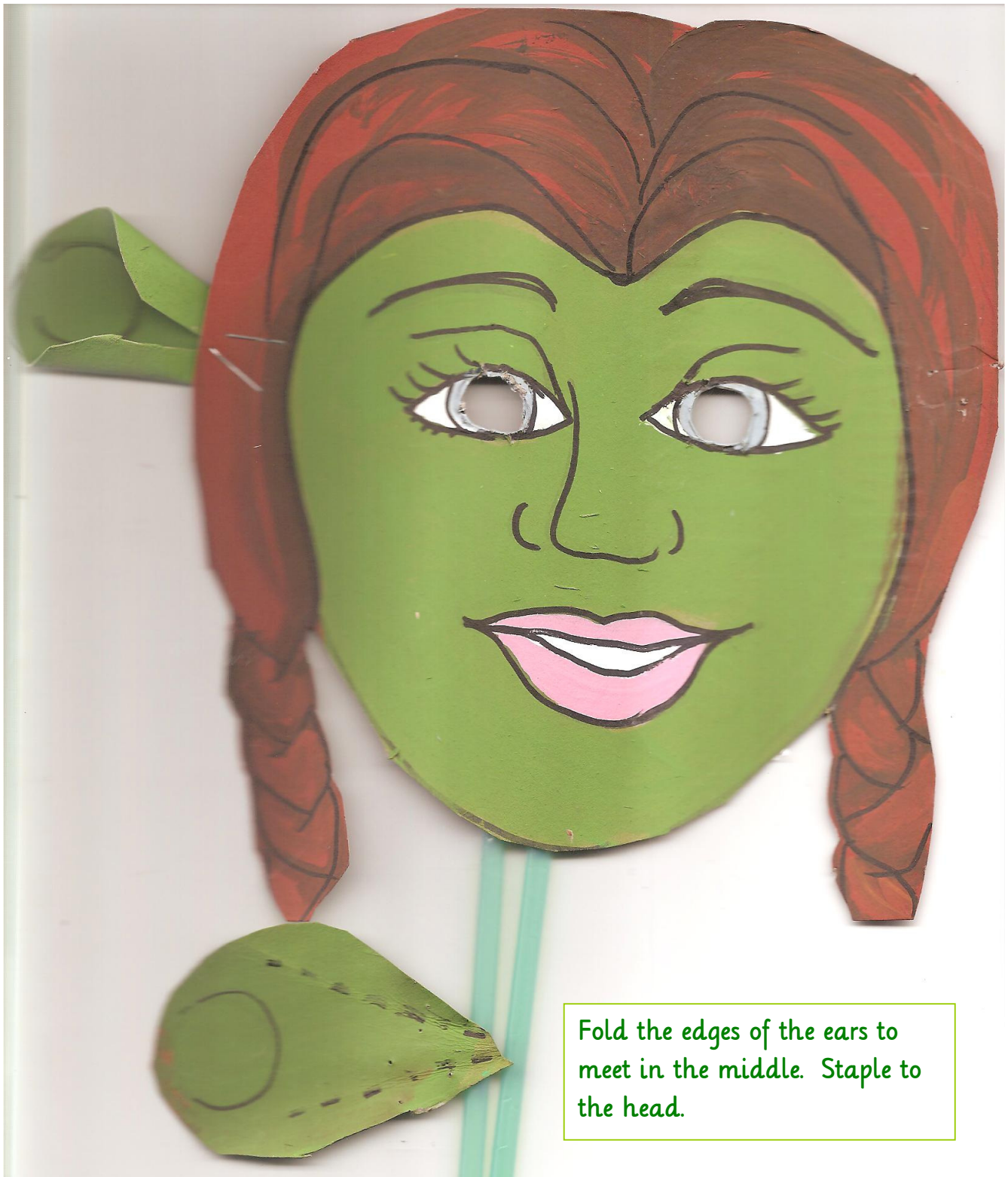


Shrek Masks

- ✿ These face masks were created using the insides of cereal boxes.
- ✿ They were mounted on straws, but you could put elastic through 2 holes at ear level to go around the head.
- ✿ The eye holes were made for young children (5 - 8 year olds) so you may need to space the holes wider for older children.
- ✿ Ears were stapled onto the head. Use tape to cover the inside edges of the staples so that these points do not scratch the children.
- ✿ Ears were painted on both sides of the cereal box cut out. I tore the glossy painted layer off carefully so that my craft paint would stick more effectively to the cardboard.
- ✿ All details were drawn with black permanent marker pen after the paint dried.
- ✿ I used the masks as décor by pegging them across the table where the party food was displayed. The masks were unclipped for play when the party games were finished.

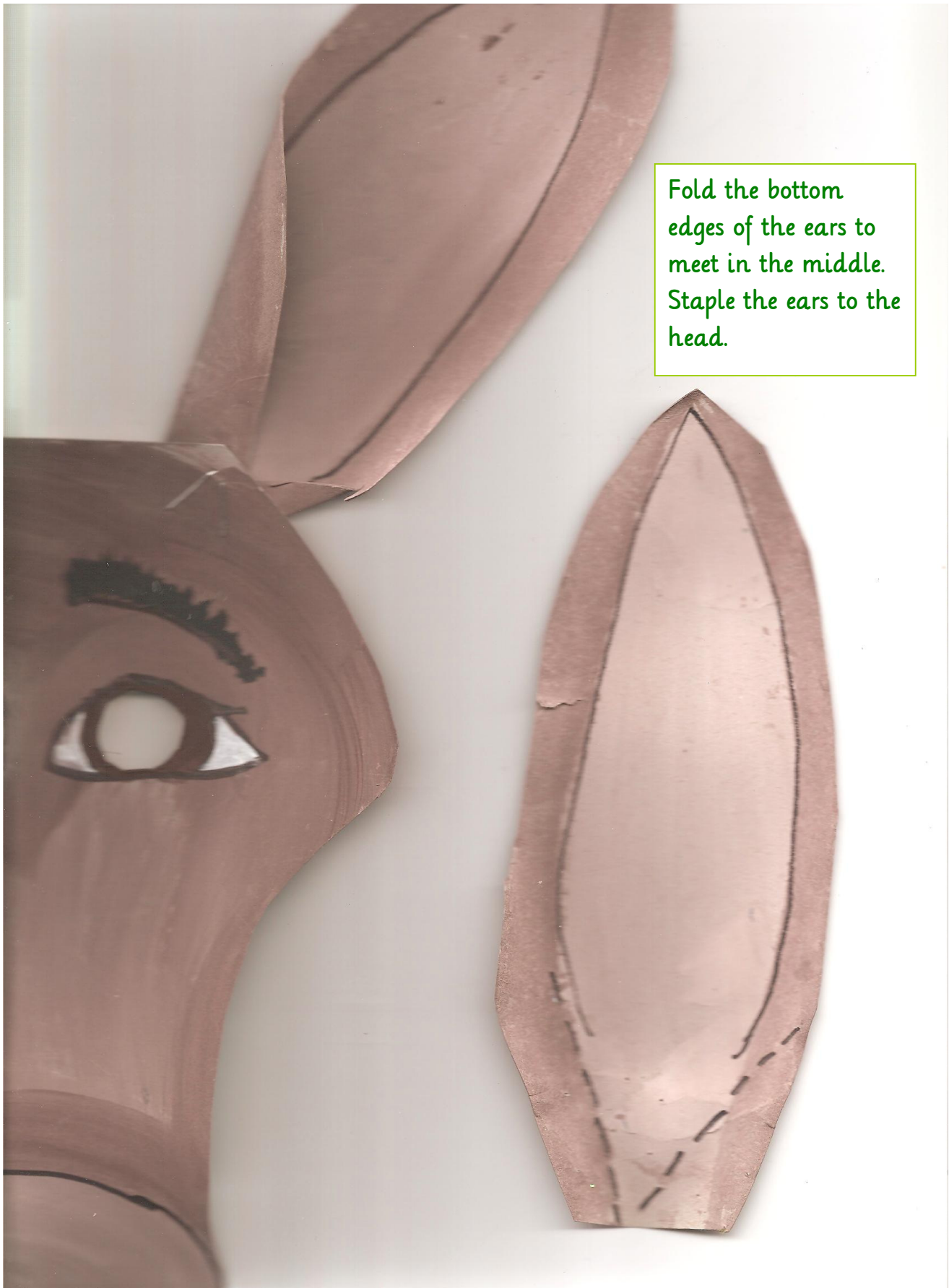


Twist the ears, secure with clear tape and staple to head.

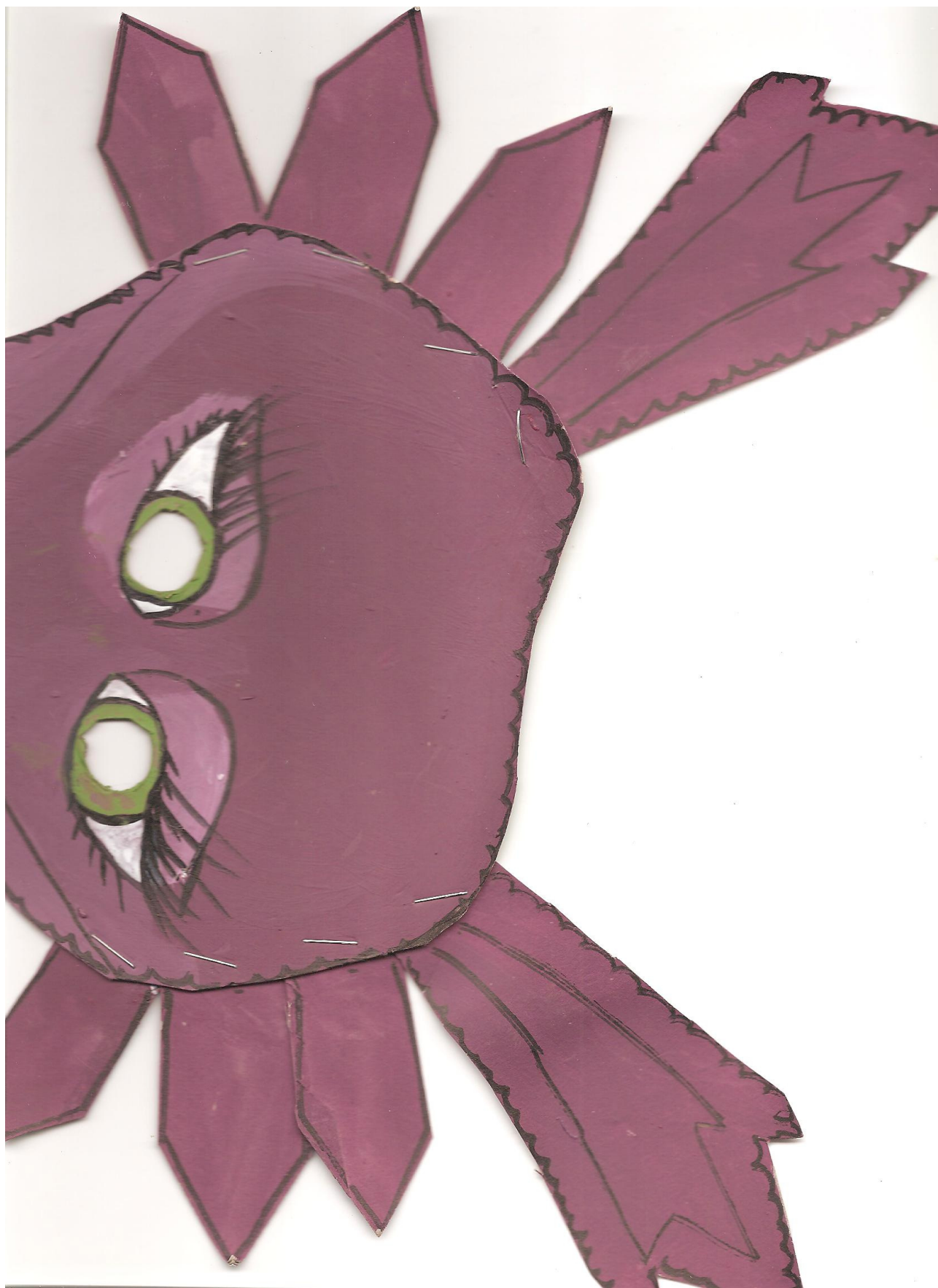


Fold the edges of the ears to meet in the middle. Staple to the head.











For a 3D effect we painted and pasted and/or stapled glasses, earrings and the hairstyle to the mask.





For a 3D effect we painted and pasted and/or stapled the hat and feather to the mask.
