

- ✓ The last page has envelope shapes you may need.
- ✓ Fold all the pages except the last page in half with the blank sides inside. Wreck the blank pages!
- ✓ The first ½ of the booklet will have ideas on the right hand page, and the 2<sup>nd</sup> ½ of the booklet will have journal prompts on the left.
- ✓ Staple, bind, tie, or secure with a twig and an elastic band.
- ✓ Use and enjoy!


# Welcome to some new fun & adventure nature journal ideas!

Be warned ~ you and your Nature Journal may get dirty or wet, but you should have some real creative fun!


### Instructions ~

Find an insect. Draw a part of the insect really big or small to exaggerate its features.




Make some mud and make a lovely muddy handprint here ~

Draw your whole landscape really small to fit into this frame:




Find a seed pod and draw describe:
